Intravesical Instillilation


Context

A local treatment by vesical instillation of Mitomycine MMC (cytotoxic drug) or BCG (bacillus Calmette-Guérin) is often recommended after Transurethral Resection of Bladder Tumor (TURBT). However handling these toxic drugs requires a high level of security to protect healthcare workers and their environment. Recognised risks are Chemical and bacteriological contamination.



Problem

Drug leakage and/or splashing during preparation, transfer, instillation and disposal.



Solution: qimocap - qimoð - qimoadapt

For the handling of toxic drugs, the Qimono range ensures a high level of security for the healthcare workers from the drug vial to the disposal of the urinary catheter.
